## Ralph Hansen, 68

Ralph Hansen was born Dec. 7, 1913 in Sharon twp., Audubon co. He was one of four children born to Peter and Marie Ingerslev Hansen. He was baptized in the Bethany Lutheran church, Kimballton and confirmed in the Elk Horn Lutheran church where he is still a member.

On March 17, 1936 he married Evelyn Jensen. Their first year of marriage they farmed in Audubon co. east of Kimballton, and from there they farmed west of Elk Horn, where he died Friday, Oct. 8, 1982.

Surviving him are his wife Evelyn of Elk Horn; two sons Richard of Milan, Mo. and Peter of Elk Horn; two daughters Doris (Mrs Henry Jones) of Streamwood, Ill. and Margaret (Mrs John Sommer) of Shellrock; 15 grandchildren and two great grandchildren. Also surviving are two brothers Herbert of Elk Horn and Ronald of Audubon; one sister Thelma Lange of Audubon. Preceding him in death were his parents and one daughter Jean.

Funeral services were held Monday, Oct. 11, 1982 in the Elk Horn Lutheran church with pastor Eugene Soland officiating and Pastor Harry Thomsen assisting. Burial was in the Elk Horn Lutheran cemetery Elk Horn with Emmert Andersen, Tony Jensen, Marvin Lange, Jim Andersen, Ronald Andersen and Gordon Lange serving as casketbearers.
