Clara R. Hartman, 99

Clara Rose Hartman, daughter of John J. and Rosina Moosmann Hartman was born June 22, 1883 in Bonnetsmill, Mo. She was baptized, received her First Communion and confirmation at the Catholic church there. She grew to adulthood with her family in Mo.

She was employed as a housekeeper for most of her life. She made her home in Mo. until 1946, when she moved to Creston. This was her home until 1965, when she became a resident of the Little Flower Haven Nursing Home in Earling. This was her home since that time. She died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Friday, Oct. 22, 1982 at the age of 99 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents, John and Rosina and is survived by cousins and other relatives.

A Mass of Christian burial was celebrated at St. Joseph's Catholic church in Earling on Monday, Oct. 25, 1982 with the Rev. Tom DeCarlo as celebrant.
