

Viderick Hartvigsen

KIMBALLTON — Viderick Hartvigsen, was born Aug. 18, 1894 in Sharon twp, Audubon county, son of Jorgen and Andrea Kallesen Hartvigsen. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. He served two years in WWI. During his time he was stationed in France for one year. On Mar. 17, 1920 he married Mary Knudsen in her parents home. They farmed one year in Viola twp. and then moved to Mary's home place, northeast of Kimballton, where they farmed and lived for 56 years. In failing health Viderick was moved to the Friendship Home in Audubon and then hospitalized in Veterans' hospital in Omaha. Thursday, April 28, 1977, he was transferred to the Thomas Rest Haven in Coon Rapids, where he died Saturday, April 30, 1977 at age 82 years.

Viderick was preceded in death by his parents, four sisters, one infant brother and one daughter, Altha (Mrs Kenneth Poley). Survivors include his wife - Mary, three sons - Vogel Hart-

vigsen and Merle Hartvigsen of Kimballton, George Hartvigsen of Mediapolis, Ia., two sisters - Clara Andersen of Centerville, So. Dak., Pemia Sorenson of Elk Horn and one brother - Harvig Hartvigsen of Lee Summit, Mo., 11 grandchildren and eight great grandchildren.
