The Life Story of —
MRS JOHN P. HEESE, 77

Dora L. Heese, daughter of August and Catherine Freund Langenfeld, was born February 27, 1895 in Johnsburg, Wis. She died November 5, 1972 at Myrtue Hospital, in Harlan at age 77 years, 8 months, and 8 days. In 1907 she moved with her parents and family to Earling, and has made this her home since that time. She was baptized and confirmed at St. John's Church in Johnsburg and she has been a member of St. Joseph's Church since moving to Earling. She also attended St. Joseph's school. On December 29, 1943 she married John P. Heese at St. Joseph's Church. Mrs Heese was also a member of St. Joseph's Altar Society, St. Katherine's Court No. 266 of the Catholic Daughters of America, the Catholic Knights of America, and the Third Order of St. Francis, all of Earling.

She was preceded in death by her parents; five brothers - John J., Joseph, Albert, William, and Chris Langenfeld; and two sisters - Mrs Rose Leuschen and Eulalia Langenfeld.

Surviving are her husband, John P., of Earling; one brother - Henry Langenfeld of Earling; by her nieces and nephews, other relatives and many friends.

A con-celebrated Mass of the Resurrection was celebrated No. 8, 1972 at St Joseph's Church in Earling with Rt Rev Msgr P.A. Bissen and Rev Eugene Koch as con-celebrants. Burial was in St. Joseph's cemetery in Earling with Alfons A. Klein, O.J. Langenfeld, William Leuschen, Zeno Blum, Jerry Langenfeld and Merle Langenfeld serving as pallbearers.
