DOSENA HENRICKSEN, 84

Dosena Henricksen was born June 13, 1886 in Shelby, Iowa and died April 3, 1971 in Epply Nursing Home, Omaha, Nebraska after a lingering illness at the age of 84 years, nine months and three days. Dosena was born to the family of H.N. Henricksen.

As a young girl Dosena joined the Seventh Day Adventist Church. She grew up on a farm near Shelby, and attended public schools there. She later attended Union College in Lincoln, Nebraska, preparing herself for literature ministry and Bible study work. While there she met Mrs James Johnson, who had recently come from Denmark. These two girls were Bible workers for two years in Omaha.

In 1920 she worked as an assistant to Dr Kani, an Osteopath Doctor in Omaha. Here she learned the art and work of massage and obtained a license as a masseuse in the city of Omaha. She continued this work until about 1½ years ago.

She is survived by several nieces and nephews and cousins. Her parents, six brothers and four sisters all preceded her in death.

Burial was in the Shelby Cemetery, Shelby, Iowa.
