WALNUT — Dale Walter Hoffmann, was born May 18, 1926 at Walnut, son of Walter and Elsie Kuhn Hoffmann. He graduated from Walnut Community and the University of Iowa. He married Jeanne Littleton in Omaha on Aug. 31, 1947 and this union was blessed with two children. The family had lived in Marshalltown and Denison and for the past eight years in Ft. Dodge. He was employed with the Federal Deposit Insurance Corp. as a bank examiner. He was a member of the United Presbyterian church of Denison and a member of the Marshalltown American Legion and Elks club, Denison VFW and Webster County Assn. for Retarded Persons. He died suddenly at his home Jan. 2, 1977 of a heart attack.
