

The Life Story of —

MRS J. B. HOLLIDAY, 73

Evelyn Lillian Holliday, daughter of William and Sophie Eggers Marr, was born Febr. 27, 1901 in Irwin, Ia., and she grew to adulthood in this community. She died at the Colonial Manor Nursing Home in Avoca on July 2, 1974 at age 73 years, 6 months, 6 days. On Oct. 6, 1918 she married J. B. Holliday in Elk Point, So Dak. Two daughters Audrey and Evon, were born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Holliday lived in the communities of Arion, Dow City, and Denison, before moving to Harlan in 1948. This was her home until Oct. of 1971 when she became a resident of the Colonial Manor Home in Avoca.

Mrs Holliday was preceded in death by her husband, Burrell, on Apr. 27, 1964; by her daughter Evon, who died in infancy; her parents two brothers - Fred and Frank Marr; and by two sisters - Bess (Mrs Louis Galland) and Marie (Mrs Albert Schiltz). She is survived by her daughter, Audrey (Mrs Bernard McCord) of Harlan and her grandson - Sgt. Michael Shanahan with the U.S. Army at Fort L. J. McNair, Va., by her nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held on Friday, July 5, 1974 at the Pauley Home for Funerals in Harlan with Rev. Anthony J. Palmer of St. Michael's church, officiating. Burial was in Dow City cemetery with Mel White, Dean Lytle, Dyril McCord, Jerry Greiner, Ivan Martindale, and Fletcher Boggess serving as pallbearers.
