



## Robert K. Holloway, 48

Kirkman — Robert Keith Holloway, son of Uriah Scott and Lucile Davenport Holloway was born Jan. 11, 1933, on a farm in Harrison County, Mo. One year later, his family moved to a farm north of Harlan, where Robert attended Douglas No. 9 County School. In 1942, they moved to a farm north of Kirkman and in 1951, Robert graduated from Kirkman high

school. He then helped on his parents farm until he was inducted into the U. S. Army in Nov., 1953. He served his country as a Private First Class until Nov. 10, 1955, when he received his honorable discharge and returned to the Kirkman area to farm.

On Feb. 14, 1960, Robert married Marcia Juhl at her parent's home east of Irwin. Three children were born to this union. After their marriage, they continued to farm in the Shelby County area. Robert died at Myrtle Memorial hospital in Harlan on Feb. 21, 1981, at age 48 years, 1 month and 10 days.

He is survived by his wife, Marcia of Defiance; his son, Kevin and two daughters, Suzanne and Lori, all living at home; his parents, Mr and Mrs Scott Holloway of Kirkman; six brothers, O. E.
