

Zeta Hotze, 87

Zeta Margarite Hotze, daughter of Rose Ralls and Norman Reeder was born March 10, 1896 at Panama. She attended school in Dunlap and later worked in Sac City where she met Harley J. Anderson. They were married July 3, 1915, at Denison, and to this union two sons were born. They lived in Sac City for eight years and moved to Dunlap in 1926.

On April 30, 1956, she married Lewis Hotze at Nashua. Zeta was an active member of the Dunlap Congregational church and has resided in Dunlap until 1980, when she became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan.

She died at Myrtle Memorial hospital in Harlan at the age of 87 years, 4 months and 14 days.

Mrs Hotze was preceded in death by her parents; her first husband Harley Anderson in 1952; her second husband Lewis Hotze in 1973; two brothers, Jasper Reeder and Russell Reeder and one sister, Bessie Cook Ronk. Survivors include two sons, Norman Anderson and his wife Bernadine of Kirkman and Mardis Anderson and his wife Kay of Richardson, Texas; six grandchildren; four great grandchildren; many nieces and nephews, other relatives and a host of friends.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, July 27, 1983 at the Dunlap Congregational church with Rev. Ray Reimer, officiating.
