

THE LIFE STORY OF

Albert "Al" P. Huebner, 74

Albert Peter Huebner, son of Joseph P. and Josephine Graeve Huebner was born Sept. 6, 1910, on a farm near Portsmouth. He was baptized, received his First Communion and confirmed at St. Mary's Catholic church in Portsmouth. Al attended St. Mary's Catholic school in Portsmouth and grew to adulthood on the family farm.

On Feb. 22, 1938, he married Helen Skalla at St. Mary's Catholic church in Portsmouth. Two sons were born to this union. After their marriage they farmed near Portsmouth until 1963. He then went to work at the Union Stock Yards in Omaha, Neb., but they continued to live on the farm near Portsmouth. After retiring in 1976 they continued to live on the farm.

Mr Huebner was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church in Portsmouth. He died at Mercy hospital in Co. Bluffs on Thursday, Sept. 20, 1984, at the age of 74 years and 14 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents. In addition to his wife Helen of Portsmouth, he is survived by two sons and daughters-in-law Robert and Pauline Huebner and Ronald and Susan Huebner all of Co. Bluffs; eight grandchildren; nieces; nephews and other relatives.
