MRS SUSAN HUEBNER, 87

Portsmouth — Susan Huebner, daughter of Mathias and Anna Pertzborn Trieweiler was born on a farm near Pierce, Nebr., on Mar. 2, 1888. She died at the Clovis Sanitorium in Clovis, Calif., on Dec. 31, 1975, at age 87 years, 9 months and 29 days. She attended school and grew to adulthood on her parent's farm. She was baptized and confirmed in the Catholic church. She moved to Portsmouth as a young adult. On April 21, 1914, she married Frank Huebner at St. Mary's Catholic church in Portsmouth. Two children were born to this union. Mr and Mrs Huebner farmed two miles southwest of Portsmouth for 30 years. In 1944 they moved into Portsmouth and it was here Mr Huebner died in 1957. Mrs Huebner was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Frank; three brothers; and eight sisters. She is survived by her daughter, Annabelle (Mrs Ralph Black) of Coalinga, Calif.; her son, Albert Walter Huebner of La Habra, Calif. and five grandchildren; by a brother, Matt Trieweiler of Milwaukee, Wisc., a sister, Molley (Mrs Ray Wormley) of Alhambra, Calif.; nieces and nephews and other relatives.
