Manilla — Anne Marie Jacobsen, daughter of Dale K. and Marilyn Lakers Jacobsen, was born, July 10, 1960, in Upland, Calif. Following the death of her father, as a young child, she moved to Manilla with her mother where she attended school, graduating from Manilla high school in 1978. At the present time she was a sophomore at the University of Northern Iowa in Cedar Falls. She died instantly in an auto accident on Friday, Jan. 4, 1980, at 19 years, 5 months and 24 days, near Dike, while returning from home to the university. Anne was a member of the Sacred Heart Parish of Manilla.
