AMANDA JENSEN, 88

Elk Horn — Amanda Jensen, daughter of Cornelius and Anna Karsen and Kelson was born Oct. 1, 1886 in Oxford, N. J., She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran church. On June 27, 1906 she married Andrew Jensen in Co. Bluffs. This union was blessed with four children. Her husband was a pharmacist in Co. Bluffs when they were married. They came to Elk Horn in 1920 where he had a drug store until 1947, when he worked in Audubon and Atlantic. Mr and Mrs Jensen lived in the Salem Homes from 1969 till early 1970, where Andrew died. After his death Amanda moved to California with her daughter, Viola. She died in San Luis Obispo, Calif., on June 12, 1975 at age 88 years, 8 months and 12 days.

Mrs Jensen was preceded in death by her husband, her parents and three sisters. Survivors include two daughters - Viola (Mrs Art) Soe of Pismo Beach, Calif., Irene (Mrs Alvin) Hansen of Bussy; two sons - Bernard Jensen of Dows and Cornelius Jensen of Seattle, Wash.; four grandchildren, eight great grandchildren and one sister Sophie (Mrs Chester) Rasmussen of Council Bluffs.

Funeral services were held June 16, 1975 at the Elk Horn Lutheran church with Pastor Lester Larson, officiating. Burial was in the Elk Horn cemetery with Kenneth Potts, Leroy Pedersen, Hans Weddum, Howard Sorensen, Ed Madsen and Warren Jacobsen serving as pallbearers.
