## Conrad Jensen

Conrad Jensen, son of Jens and Marie Olsen was born in Vgilt, Denmark, Nov. 21, 1899. He died at Mercy hospital in Iowa City, on Dec. 30, 1976 at age 77 years, one month and 9 days. He attended school and grew to adulthood in Denmark. Conrad came to the U. S. in 1920 and settled in Washington, Nebr. He married Bethel Seymour on Mar. 28, 1928 in Omaha, Nebr. Three children were born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Jensen farmed in the Washington, Nebr., vicinity until 1940 when they moved to a farm near Harlan in Shelby county. They retired from the farm in 1970 and made their home in Harlan until 1975 when they moved to Iowa City.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two half-brothers - Emil Olsen and Aksel Olsen; a half-sister, Ingrid Knudsen; and a granddaughter, Amy Lynn Robinson. He is survived by his wife, Bethel, of Iowa City; son, Robert D. Jensen of Solon, Ia., two daughters - Shirley (Mrs Newell Taylor) of Colorado Springs, Colo. and Ellen (Mrs Melford G. Robinson) of Iowa City; and by eight grandchildren, by one brother, John Jensen of Fremont, Nebr.; one sister, Sena Rhea of San Francisco, Calif.; two half-brothers - Peter Olsen of

Washington, Nebr. and Nels Olsen of Ft. Wayne, Ind.; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home on Monday, Jan. 3, 1977 with Rev. E. Robert Petersen of Iowa City officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery, with Harry Krohn, Allan Knudsen, John Andersen, Douglas Linden, Anton Petersen and Mervin Schnack serving as casketbearers.
