Elma L. Jensen, born Jan. 27, 1897, to William Browns of Fairfield, Ill. She was adopted in 1899 by Alvin Iveys of Manilla. She moved from Manilla to Perry, in 1926, and was employed by Ringheim's Dry Goods Store until her marriage. She married Oliver Jensen on March 9, 1927. Mr Jensen died on Sept. 10, 1977. She was a resident of Perry for 54 years, until moving to the Davis Nursing Home in Denver, Colo., in 1980, where she died on Wednesday, July 21, 1982.

She was a member of the Methodist church, Order of the Eastern Star, Milwaukee RR Clubs, and other community organizations.
