

## Otilie S. Jensen, 85

Otilie Jensen was born March 28, 1898 in Aalborg, Denmark. She was one of seven children born to Otto and Jensine Paulsen. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran church of Denmark. She was currently a member of the Elk Horn Lutheran church in Elk Horn.

She married Anders K. Jensen, Feb. 4, 1923 in Denmark. She came with Anders to America just after they were married. He had been here previously. They farmed in Rorbeck for 25 years and then moved to 2½ miles south of Elk Horn in 1943.

He died in Sept. of 1966. She continued to live on the home place with her son, Dale, until 1974 when she moved to the 4-plex in Elk Horn. Then on Jan. 2, 1976 she moved to the Salem Nursing Home where she died Saturday, May 7, 1983.

Surviving her are three sons: Earl of Mason City, Dale of Elk Horn and Glenn of Marion; one daughter: Mabel (Mrs Bob) Madsen of Elk Horn; eight grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. Preceding her in death were her parents, her husband, and six brothers and sisters.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, May 10, 1983 in the Elk Horn Lutheran church with Pastor Eugene Soland officiating and Pastor Harry Thomsen assisting. The Rev. Akihiko Tominaga was the liturgist. Burial was in the Elk Horn Lutheran cemetery, Elk Horn with Pete Jensen, Sophus Jensen, Anton Petersen, Anton Jensen, Hugo Cordes and Thomas Nelson serving as casketbearers.
