

Julius Jorgensen, 83

Julius James Jorgensen, 83, Stratford died at Mary Greely hospital in Ames Friday, July 2, 1982.

He was born on Nov. 5, 1898 in Shelby Co., the son of Peter and Mary Rasmussen Jorgensen. On June 21, 1928, he married Beulah Anderson at Des Moines.

He was a school administrator in various schools for 40 years, retiring in 1967 as Buchanan Co. Supt. of schools at Independence. He was superintendent of Irwir schools for a period of time. He and his wife moved back to Stratford where he had served as Supt. of schools from 1945 to 1956.

He was a member of the Calvary United Methodist church, charter member of Stratford Lions club, member of Masonic Acorn Lodge No. 601. A.M. of Stratford, a member of the order of Eastern Star and Ed Kohir Shrine of Cedar Rapids. He was a life member of the National Education Association, the Iowa Association of school administrators.

Survivors include his wife Beulah and two sons Richard of Ft. Dodge and Tom of Ames; one daughter (Mary Ann) Mrs William Holliday of Bloomington, Minn.; eight grandchildren, one sister Mrs Harold (Eleanor) Nelson of Denuhua, Calif. His parents and three brothers Elmer, Harry and Everett Jorgensen preceded him in death.

Services were held Tuesday, July 6, 1982 at Calvary United Methodist church with Rev. Coloris Rossman officiating. Burial was in the South Marion cemetery with Masonic graveside services.
