Elk Horn-Randall Ray Juelsgaard, son of Ronald and Beverly Lund Juelsgaard, was born May 28, 1961 in Harlan. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran church, where he recently served as worship assistant at the Elk Horn church.

He attended school at Jefferson until fifth grade when he went for a year to the Elk Horn school and had since gone to school in Exira. He was active in baseball, football and wrestling, president of the Exira Future Farmers and secretary of the SW Iowa District FFA. He was a candidate of State FFA V.P. and President of the SW Iowa District. He had planned to attend NWMSU at Maryville, Mo. He was killed in an auto accident south of Clarinda Friday, Febr 22, 1980 at age 18 years.

He was preceded in death by his grandfather, Harold Lund and an uncle, Jack Juelsgaard. Survivors include his parents, a sister, Robin; a brother, Brian; his grandparents, Norman Juelsgaards of Elk Horn and Mr. and Mrs. Lawrence Alff of Casey
