Anna Kahl, daughter of John and Georgine Wesselman Glissmann was born Sept. 28, 1890 near Walnut. She was married to Henry Kahl at Walnut on Dec. 18, 1918 and they farmed until 1945, when they moved to Walnut.

She was a member of the Walnut Presbyterian church and an active worker in United Presbyterian women. Mr Kahl died April 15, 1976 and she soon moved to Peace Haven Home in Walnut. She was a resident there until Aug., 1980, when she moved to the Lutheran Home in Omaha, nearer her daughter, Betty. She lived there until her death on Thursday, March 24, 1983, following a brief illness.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs Alex (Betty) Naran of Omaha and Mrs Carl (Ruth) Reeves of Whittier, Calif.; five grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
