AVOCA — Services are this morning (Thursday) at 10:30 in the Trinity Lutheran Church here for longtime civic leader Creighton Kaven, 62, who died Monday night at the Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Council Bluffs. Burial will be in the Minden Cemetery.

Kaven, who served on the city council 12 years before resigning in 1978 due to health reasons, suffered a heart attack Monday morning, according to Berthusen-Knutson Funeral Home in Avoca.

A building contractor, Kaven served 22 years on the

fire department and was its treasurer at the time of death. He was also a past president of the Avoca Community Club, and was active in many civic organizations.

Survivors include his wife, Geneva; one son, Dale of Schuyler, Nebr.; two daughters - Mrs Dennis (Jane) Turner of Atlantic and Mrs Chuck (Mary Leigh) Morris, Ames; seven grandchildren; his mother, Emma Kaven of Minden.
