Gladys Velora Kevan, daughter of William S. and Ellen Kite Kevan, was born in Shelby co., Sept. 8, 1899.

She graduated from Walnut high school in 1918 and later from Simpson college in Indianola and taught in country schools in the Walnut area. She was a member of the Monroe Methodist church.
