

Shelby L. Knudson, 71

Shelby Lundby Knudson, son of Martinus and Anna Lundby Knudson, was born Jan. 3, 1910 on a farm in Cuppy's Grove, Shelby co. He was baptized at the Altamont Baptist church and attended the country school, both in Shelby co. He grew to adulthood helping on the family farm.

On Aug. 24, 1939, he married Wyonne Jorgensen in Papillion, Neb. Two daughters, Marci and Sandi, were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed near Cuppy's Grove until 1943, when they moved to their present farm near Shelby. It was at this time that he became a member of the United Methodist church in Shelby. He died in Apache Junction, Ariz. on Monday, Dec. 21, 1981 at the age of 71 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Martinus and Anna. He is survived by his wife, Wyonne of Shelby; two daughters: Marci (Mrs Doug) Robinson of Shelby and Sandi (Mrs Dan) Hynes of Broomfield, Colo.; five grandchildren; one brother, Wallace of Harlan and one sister, Shirley Pingel of Ozark Acres, Ark.; nieces, nephews and other relatives.
