Alfred Kramer

EARLING — Alfred J. Kramer was born Dec. 13, 1907 in Earling, son of Alvin and Margaret Tremel Kramer. On May 7, 1934 he married Dorothy Leuschen in Panama. He was employed at John Deere Waterloo Tractor Works for 28 years, retiring in 1972. He died Sunday, March 22, 1977 at St. Francis hospital.
