

**Christine V. Krueger, 89** . June 22, 1983 pg 2B

Christine Valentine Krueger, daughter of James P. and Susan Dermeyer Zimmerman was born Feb. 14, 1894 at her parents home in Lincoln twp., Pottawattamie co. She received her education in the country school and was married March 9, 1920 to Henry F. Krueger.

Their first home was on the Walter Krueger farm, south of Walnut and their two children were born there. In 1934 they moved to their own farm northeast of Walnut. They were members of and both active in Peace United Church of Christ in Walnut.

After Mr Krueger's death on April 27, 1954, she moved into Walnut and maintained her home until she was 83 years of age. In 1977 she moved to Peace Haven Home in Walnut, remaining active in church mission work and her social clubs. She suffered a stroke in May, 1983, entered Cass co. Memorial hospital and died there on Saturday, May 21, 1983.

She was preceded in death by her parents; four brothers, Ralph, Ezra, James and Edgar Zimmerman; two sisters, Mrs Blanche Schwartz and Mrs Carrie Johnk. She is survived by one sons, Orville Krueger and one daughter, Mrs Wilber (Iona) Hubbard; grandchildren, Neal, Clark, Alan and Mark Hubbard, Jeff Krueger, Lori (Mrs Charles) Lambrecht and Julie Krueger; and a great-grandson Nicholas Krueger; one sister, Mrs Ethel Osler of Griswold.

Funeral services were held Monday, May 23, 1983 at Peace United Church of Christ, with the Rev. Bruno Romanowski, officiating.
