

Elizabeth C. Kuchel, 75

Irwin — Elizabeth Caroline Kuchel, daughter of Henry and Bertha Saltwell Meyer, was born Oct. 6, 1902 on a farm southeast of Manilla. She attended the rural school near her home and on Dec. 26, 1928 she married Edwin Kuchel. This union was blessed with two daughters. After farming near Irwin and Manilla the family moved to a farm in Audubon county for eight years and retired to Manilla in 1970. Edwin died on Febr. 7, 1977 and since that time Elizabeth made her home at the Manilla Manor. She died Sunday, Nov. 27, 1977 at the Crawford County Memorial hospital in Denison at age 75 years, one month and 21 days.

She was preceded in death by one grandson, her parents and four brothers. Survivors include two daughters — Charlyn (Mrs Amos) Armstrong of Clinton, Mo. and Janelle (Mrs Tony) Murdock of Fortuna, Calif., four grandchildren and two brothers — Henry Meyer of Manilla and Louie Meyer of Grants Pass., Oreg., and other relatives.
