Walnut — Gretchen Kuhr, daughter of the John Nelsons of Marne, was born Jan. 2, 1901, and died Wednesday, Aug. 8, 1979, at the Cass County Memorial hospital in Atlantic.

She attended school in Marne, and married Otto Kuhr on April 4, 1919. They lived in Atlantic, Marne and the Walnut areas. She was a member of Peace United Church of Christ in Walnut. Mr Kuhr died April 20, 1959, as the result of a car accident in Mo. She was in failing health since that time and lived in a Co. Bluffs nursing home and last two years in the Atlantic Care Center.
