Mae Lange

ELK HORN — Mae Lange, daughter of Christian Wilhelm and Mary Petersen Boysen, was born Aug. 17, 1907 on a farm in Jackson twp. near Kimballton. She was baptised and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. On April 10, 1936 she married Andrew Lange. They lived in Elk Horn where Mr Lange operated a John Deere Implement Co. until his death. Mae died at her home in Elk Horn on Oct. 1, 1976 at age 69 years, 1 month and 16 days.

She was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, and a brother - Arthur Boysen. Survivors include a sister - Mrs Leo Larsen of Colorado Springs, a niece - Mrs Daniel Griffin and a nephew, Lynn Larsen of Colorado Springs.
