Langenfeld, daughter of Joseph and Rosalia Zimmerman Rosenthal, was born Nov. 29, 1894, in Westphalia. She died in Westphalia on Feb. 15, 1975, at age 80 years, 2 months and 28 days. She attended St. Boniface school in Westphalia and was baptized and confirmed in St. Boniface Catholic church. She married John Langenfeld on Jan. 30, 1923, at St. Boniface Catholic church in Westphalia. Four children were born to this union. After their marriage, Mr and Mrs Langenfeld farmed southwest of Westphalia until 1947 when they moved back to Westphalia. Mrs Langenfeld was a lifetime member of St. Boniface Catholic church, and was also a past member of the St. Boniface Altar Society. For many years she was an active member of the Panama
