Elk Horn — Eda Florence Larsen, daughter of Nels and Christina Hansen Christensen, was born Dec. 9, 1886 on a farm just east of Elk Horn. She died Oct. 5, 1979 at Salem Nursing Home in Elk Horn where she had been a resident the past three years.

Mrs Larsen attended country school near her home. On Feb. 20, 1907 she married Dan Larsen and four children were born to this union.

The couple farmed for a number of years in Audubon County. In 1939 they moved to Kimballton where they lived until 1965 when they moved to Elk Horn. Mr Larsen passed away Oct. 5, 1971. She was a life-long member of West Exira Seventh Day Advent Church.
