LOUIS LARSON, 88

IRWIN — Louis, son of Lars and Annie Nielsen Larson, was born May 30, 1886 near Irwin. He attended rural schools near his home. Louis worked at farming, railroading and the like for most of his adult life, finally making his home in Minneapolis in later years. He died Friday, June 14, 1974 at the Bryn Mawr Nursing Home in Minneapolis, at age 88 years, 14 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents - three brothers and one sister. Survivors include one brother, Lester Larson of Irwin, nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, June 18 at St. Paul's Lutheran church in Irwin with Pastor Marvin L. Hagen, officiating. Burial was in Danway cemetery near Irwin.
