Matie Marie Larson, daughter of Andrew and Marie Christensen Hansen was born Nov. 21, 1894, on a farm in Center twp., Shelby co. She was baptized at the Bethlehem Lutheran church and attended the Jackson No. 9 country school. She grew to adulthood helping on the family farm.

On May 8, 1918, she married Celius Peter Larson at the Bethlehem Lutheran church. Three children were born to this union. After their marriage, they farmed in Center twp. This was their home until 1947, when they retired and moved to Harlan. After Mr Larson died on Feb. 1, 1975, she continued to make her home in Harlan.

She joined the Methodist church in 1940 and has been a member of the First United Methodist church in Harlan since that time. She died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Monday, June 21, 1982, at the age of 87 years.

In addition to her husband and parents, she was preceded in death by one great granddaughter, Kaylene Rasmussen and one brother, Walter Hansen. She is survived by her son, Clarence of Harlan and two daughters, Marie Evelyn (Mrs Kenneth E.) Nielsen of Olympia Fields, Ill. and Darlene (Mrs John H. Rasmussen of Harlan; eight grandchildren, eleven great grandchildren and three step great grandchildren; two brothers, Ernest and Lester Hansen, both of Harlan; one sister, Edna Hansen of Irwin; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held at Pauley Funeral Home on Wednesday, June 23, 1982, with Dr. Larry LaVelle of the First United Methodist church in Harlan officiating.

Burial was in the Jacksonville cemetery with Ron Nielsen, Norval Larson, Ray H. Larson, Carlyle Larson, Ricky Rasmussen and Victor R. Blair serving as casketbearers.
