



THE LIFE STORY OF —

Hazel L. McCord, 89

Hazel LaVerne Grabill McCord, the daughter of Lydia Philson Grabill and John Wesley Grabill, was born Sept. 17, 1894, on a farm in Shelby co., east of Harlan.

She attended rural school in Center twp. and was a member of the Bowman's Grove Baptist church where she was a part-time organist. She was a charter member of the Center twp. C.C. club and active in 4-H work.

On Jan. 22, 1913, she married Bradley McCord at the home of her parents. They lived their married life on a farm near her parent's home. To this union two children were born, a daughter Darle (Mrs Clifford) Pedersen and a son Lynn McCord, both of Harlan.

After the death of her husband in 1954, she continued to live on the farm, until 1958. She then moved to East Market St. in Harlan and lived there until Feb. of this year, when due to failing health, she mov-

ed to the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan, where she resided until her death. She died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan on Oct. 21, 1983, having been ill for several weeks. She had died at the age of 89 years, one month and four days.

Preceding her in death besides her husband, were her parents; a brother, Herman; a sister Nina (Mrs Almer) Hansen and one grandson Lane Christensen.

She is survived by her two children; 6

grandchildren; two step-grandchildren; 12 great-grandchildren and 7 step-great-grandchildren. She is also survived by one brother Gale Grabill and a sister Velma (Mrs Lake) Greene both of Harlan; nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, Oct. 25, 1983 at Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan with Pastor Raymon Pedersen, officiating and Brother Gary Domina, Assisting.
