HOWARD S. McKEE, 81

Howard Sloan McKee was born, Oct. 1, 1892 in Biggsville, Ill., where he attended school and grew to adulthood. He died at the Baptist Memorial Home in Harlan, on Sept. 21, 1974, just 10 days before his 82nd birthday. On Oct. 16, 1916 he married Anna P. Ott in Monmouth, Ill. One son Fred, was born to this union. Mr and Mrs McKee were privileged to observe their 53rd wedding anniversary before her death on Nov. 29, 1969. After their marriage, they lived in Mediapolis, where Mr McKee was a Purina Dealer for 27 years. In 1956 they moved to Harlan and this has been his home since that time.

In addition to his wife, Anna, he was preceded in death by his parents and nine brothers and sisters. Mr McKee is survived by his son, Fred J. McKee and wife, Anita, of Harlan, by his nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, Sept. 24, 1974 at Pauley Home for Funerals, Harlan with Rev David E. Cave, pastor of Congregational Christian church, officiating.
