Rosalie Mischo, daughter of Casper A. and Margaret Gall Oppold was born March 28, 1884 in Panama. She was baptized at St. Boniface Catholic church in Westphalia and received her First Communion and confirmation at St. Mary's Catholic church in Panama. She attended the public school in Panama and grew to adulthood helping at home. She then worked for her brothers at Oppold's Brothers Store in Panama for a few years.

On Nov. 16, 1909 she married William Mischo at St. Mary's Catholic church in Panama. Three daughters were born to this union. After their marriage they made their home in Panama, where Mr Mischo owned and operated the Barber Shop for over 50 years. The Mischo's were privileged to celebrate their 50th wedding anniversary on Nov. 15, 1959. After Mr Mischo died on June 17, 1961, she continued to make her home in Panama with her twin daughters Celestine and Geraldine. This has been her home since that time.

She was a member of St. Mary's Catholic church in Panama and a former member of St. Mary's Rosary Society. She died at her home in Panama on Monday, May 31, 1982 at the age of 98 years.

In addition to her husband and parents, she was preceded in death by a great granddaughter Sandy Wagner; five brothers, Joe, Frank, John, Bill and Casper and two sisters, Mary and Ann. She is survived by her twin daughters, Celestine and Geraldine Mischo, both of Panama and Mary Helen (Mrs Weslie) A. Wagner of Des Moines; four grandchildren and four great grandchildren; one sister Margaret Oppold of Panama; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

A concelebrated Mass of Christian Burial was held at St. Mary's Catholic church in Panama on Thursday, June 13, 1982 with the Rev. David Fenelon as celebrant and the Rev. Fred Reischl as concelebrant.

Burial was in St. Mary's cemetery with Mike Mickels, George Leuschen, Bob Mages, Neil Kwapiszeski, Mike Mahlberg and Henry Mahlberg serving as casketbearers.
