

# Mrs Nellie Moore, 95

Elk Horn — Mrs Nellie Frances Moore, daughter of Harriett Frances Bliss and Lou G. Chipman was born March 9, 1885 near Glidden. She died Saturday, July 19, 1980 at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn, at age 95 years, four months and ten days. She was raised near Glidden and graduated from the Glidden high school. She taught rural school for a number of years. Nov. 6, 1907 she married Young Moore in Carroll. She was a housewife for five years and in 1913 moved to Glidden. She became a Harlan resident in 1970 and moved to Irwin in 1976. She has been a resident of the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home since Jun 26, 1980. She was a member of the Glidden Presbyterian church and Eastern Star, Chapter No. 1 of Carroll.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband - Young in 1936, and one sister - Maud Leonard. Survivors include one son - Merle of Irwin; one sister - Bernice Moore of Rockwell City; two grandchildren - David of Harlan and Larry of Omaha; three great grandchildren - Kristin, LaNae and Jason; by nieces, nephews and other relatives.
