Anne Margaret Mork, daughter of Hans and Christine Mork was born on a farm near Irwin, on Aug. 11, 1898.

She attended Pleasant Valley Jefferson No. 7 county school and grew to adulthood on her parents farm. She attended college in Harlan and then taught school for a short time.
