## CLARENCE C. NELSON

Clarence Christopher Nelson, the son of Jeppe and Elsie K. (Christofferson) Nelson was born on February 2, 1889 in Audubon County, Iowa. He grew to adulthood on his parents farm in Polk Township, Shelby County, Iowa and attended country school at Polk Township No. 7.

On June 4, 1917, Clarence was united in marriage to Margaret Georgesen in Tekamah, Nebraska. Three children were born to this union. After Mr. and Mrs. Nelson were married they farmed in Polk Township until 1973 when they moved into Harlan, Iowa. After Mrs. Nelson's death on October 15, 1974, Clarence continued to make his home in Harlan, until this time.

Mr. Nelson died on Sunday, October 27, 1985 at Myrtle Memorial Hospital in Harlan, Iowa having attained the age of 96 years, eight months and 25 days.

Along with his wife Margaret, he was also preceded in death by one granddaughter Lori Nelson; one sister Martha and four brothers Chris, LeRoy, Harry and C.W.
