

KIMBALLTON MAN CRITICALLY HURT IN CYCLE CRASH

Dennis L. Nelson, 21, of Kimballton, remains in the intensive care unit of Clarkson hospital in Omaha where he was taken early Monday after a motorcycle accident a mile north and about six miles west of Audubon.

The hospital at 8 a.m. Wednesday refused to disclose Nelson's condition, although Monday they reported him critical.

Sheriff's officers said Nelson and Toby Christensen, about 25, of Elk Horn, were on cycles eastbound in an area that had been closed for construction work. Nelson crashed through a road barricade from its rear. Wearing no helmet, he suffered severe head injuries and was taken to the Omaha hospital immediately after arriving at Audubon County Memorial hospital via the fire emergency unit. The accident was reported at 1:48 a.m.

Cycle accident proves fatal to Kimballton man

OMAHA — Dennis Nelson, 21, son of the Russell Nelsons of Kimballton, died Thursday at Clarkson Hospital of injuries received in a motorcycle accident July 4.

According to reports, Nelson was driving his motorcycle seven miles north of Kimballton when the cycle went through a barricade near a gravel pit.

Rites were 2 p.m. last Saturday at Elk Horn Lutheran Church.
