

Christina E. Nissen, 82

Kimballton — Christina Elizabeth Nissen, was born April 29, 1895 in Sharon twp., Audubon county, daughter of Jacob Peter and Kathrine Eureka Osen Topp. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. Lisa took a dressmaking course in Exira receiving her diploma. On Dec. 14, 1916 she married Alfred Nissen. They farmed the Nissen home place one mile north and 2½ miles west of Kimballton until they moved to Kimballton in 1954. In 1975, Lisa moved to the Salem Nursing Home in Elk Horn. Lisa was a charter member of the Social Hour Neighborhood club and a member of LCW Afternoon club. Lisa died Thursday, Nov. 10, 1977 at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan at age 82 years.

She was preceded in death by her parents, one brother, one sister and one son, Arnold and her husband, Alfred in June, 1955. Survivors include two sons: Belmont Nissen and Harold Nissen, both of Harlan, nine grandchildren, 11 great grandchildren, one sister - Esther (Mrs Hans T.) Rasmussen, of Valborg Home in Des Moines, one brother, Peter Topp of Calistoga, Calif.
