Irwin — Albert Carl Nordby, son of Lewis and Elfreida Frank Nordby was born Oct. 5, 1900 on a farm north of Irwin. He was baptized and confirmed at St. Paul's Lutheran church in Irwin and attended the county schools, later graduating from Irwin high school in 1916. He then began farming and has done so for the last 65 years.

On Sept. 8, 1941, he married Eva Mae Cole in Maryville, Mo. Three children were born to this union. Shortly after their marriage they moved to Albert's fathers' farm north of Irwin and have been farming there ever since. Mr Nordby was a lifetime member of St. Paul's Lutheran church, Irwin. He died at his home, Saturday, Jan. 10, 1981 at age of 80 years, three months and five days.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by three brothers - Arlo, Rinehardt and Leonard Nordby; two step brothers - Carl and Ernest Schroeder and one step sister - Bertha Leaders. Survivors include his wife Eva Mae of Irwin; two sons - Dwain and Lyle of Irwin; a daughter Betty (Mrs Ted) Larsen of Royal; eight grandchildren, nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Jan. 14, 1981 at St. Paul's Lutheran church, Irwin with Pastor Emil Martinson, officiating. Burial was in Oak Hill cemetery at Irwin.
