Portsmouth — Susanna M. Olig, was born Feb. 2, 1887 in Portsmouth, daughter of Matthias and Anna Hammes Leinen. She attended country school near Portsmouth and was baptized and confirmed in St. Mary's church.

On Oct. 12, 1909 she married Mathias Olig in Portsmouth. This union was blessed with ten children. She died at Bergan Mercy hospital on Tuesday, Jan. 22, 1980 at age 92 years, 11 months and 20 days.

She was preceded in death by two children - Olive (Mrs Elmer Schlick) and Joseph, both of Omaha. Survivors include eight children: Ann (Mrs Elmer) Hennes of Omaha, Nebr.; Madge (Mrs J. C.)
