Elk Horn — Frede Olsen, son of Carl and Anna Hansen Olsen, was born Dec. 1, 1886 in Siagelse, Denmark. He received his education in the Denmark schools. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith. On Dec. 2, 1916 he married Anna Paulsen in Co. Bluffs. This union was blessed with six children. He worked as a printer in Elk Horn and Kimballton for 44 years. He died at the Salem Nursing Home in Elk Horn on Tuesday, Jan. 23, 1979 at age 92 years, one month and 22 days.
