## Minnie Palmer, 91

Walnut — Winnie Palmer, daughter of Edward and Mary Morgan Palmer, was born May 27, 1889 in Frankfort, Ohio and died Saturday, Nov. 22, 1980 at Cass County Memorial hospital in Atlantic at age 91 years, five months and 25 days. She attended the Frankfort country school, she married Allison Palmer on July 4, 1907 in South Salem, Ohio. They lived in Ohio and Ind., before moving to Iowa in 1912. They farmed in the Walnut, Wiota and Atlantic areas and her husband died Nov. 10, 1956.

She moved to Walnut in 1963 and later lived for 3½ years at the Peace Haven. She moved to the Heritage House in Atlantic, Dec. 10, 1975. She was a member of the Wiota and Buck Creek Methodist churches and served as president of the Women's Society of both churches. She organized a Wiota Garden club. On moving to Walnut, she joined the Presbyterian church. She was also a member of the Garden club.

She was preceded in death by her husband; a son, Daniel; her parents; a sister, five brothers; a grandson, Jody Thraen and a great-granddaughter, Angie Palmer. Survivors include two daughters, Mrs Melvin (Ardelle) Sievers of Walnut and Mrs Joe (Erma) Thraen of Omaha; a son, William Palmer of Spencer; ten grandchildren; 30 great-grandchildren, a sister, Bertha Parker of Bloomingburg, Ohio, nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held Monday, Nov. 24, 1980 at the Walnut First United Methodist church with Rev. Harvey Beach, officiating. Burial was in the Walnut cemetery with Tim Palmer, Tony Thraen, Bill Grow, Marvin Andersen, Paul Simonsen and Bryan Simonsen, serving as casketbearers.
