

Alfred Paulsen

IRWIN — Alfred Henry Paulsen, son of Paul and Maria Gorchich Paulsen, was born Febr. 10, 1901 in Irwin. He graduated from the Irwin high school in 1918 and then attended various business colleges. He became a partner with his father and brother, Carl in the Irwin General Store. He married Fern Monson on Oct. 18, 1934. They moved to Manning in 1938 where Alfred operated a ready to wear store for 14 years. He then went on the road selling ready to wear clothing. The family lived a short time in Ft. Morgan, Colo., in Lincoln, Nebr., four years in Harlan and at present in Irwin. He died at Myrtue Memorial hospital on Sunday, Jan. 16, 1977 at age 75 years, 11 months and 6 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents, five brothers and 2 sisters. Survivors include his wife, two daughters, Susan (Mrs Orlin Pauley) of Harlan, Linda (Mrs Eugene Dahl) of Morton, Ill., and four grandchildren, one sister - Mrs Anna Larson of Irwin and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, Jan. 18, 1977 in St. Paul's Lutheran church in Irwin with Pastor Emil Martinson, officiating. Burial was in Oak Hill cemetery in Irwin with Richard Larson, Cyrus Monson, Eugene Monson, Marty Monson, Richard VanGundy and Russell Thompson serving as casketbearers.
