

## Life Story of

### CARL PAUTSCH, 77

Funeral services were held for Carl Pautsch from the Trinity Lutheran church in Matilda Tuesday, January 6, 1959. He died at the Memorial Hospital in Denison January 3 at the age of 77 years, 4 months, and 24 days. Rev. L. W. Kutschmann officiated at the services and interment was in the Lutheran cemetery in Denison.

Pallbearers were George Evers, Jack Topl, William Evers, Max Johnson and Eric Huchner.

Carl John Pautsch was born August 10, 1881, in Hanover township, Crawford county and died Saturday, Jan. 3 1959.

In infancy he was baptized in St. Paul's Lutheran church in Hanover township, and was later confirmed in the same church.

December 14, 1914, he was united in marriage to Anna M. May and to this union four daughters were born.

Mr. Pautsch spent most of his life in Denison communally.

They lived on a farm in Washington township for 14 years. The past five years they made their home in Matilda.

He was a member of Zion Lutheran church in Denison for 40 years and of the Trinity Lutheran church in Matilda since April 1954.

Surviving are his wife and adopted son, Robert, at home, three daughters, Vera (Mrs. Ezra C. Kuehne) of La Harpe Falls; Grace (Mrs. Walter Ritts) of Boone; Dorothy (Mrs. Wayne Schuler) of Denison;

one sister, Mrs. Minnie Huebner of Denison and two grandchildren. Preceding him in death were one daughter, Viola at the age of 9; five brothers, Emil, George, Robert, Ben, and Carl, and two sisters, Theresa and Ida.
