

Life Story of

CARL PAUTSCH, 77

Funeral services were held for Carl Pautsch from the Trinity Lutheran church in Manila Tuesday, January 6, 1939. He died at the Memorial hospital in Denson January 3, at the age of 77 years, 4 months, and 24 days. Rev. L. W. Nuttmann officiated at the services and interment was in the Lutheran cemetery in Denson.

Pallbearers were George Evers, Jack Topf, William Egers, NASS PAUTSCH and Eric Hübner.

Carl John Pautsch was born August 10, 1861, in Hanover township, Crawford county and died Saturday, Jan. 3, 1939.

In infancy he was baptized in St. Pauls Lutheran church in Hanover township, and was later confirmed in the same church.

December 14, 1914, he was united in marriage to Anna In May and to this union four daughters were born.

Mr Pautsch spent most of his life in Denson community. They lived on a farm in Wash region township for 14 years. The past five years they made their home in Manila.

He was a member of Zion Lutheran church in Denson for 47 years, and of the Trinity Lutheran church in Manila since April 1934.

Surviving are his wife and adopted son, Robert, at home, three daughters, Vera (Mrs. Eva C. Kreyer) of La Harbra Falls; Grace (Mrs. Walter Russell) of Boone; Dorothy (Mrs. Wayne Schuler) of Denson;

one sister, Mrs. Minnie Hübner of Denson and two grandchildren. Preceding him in death were one daughter, Viola at the age of 9; five brothers, Emil, George, Robert, Ben, and Carl, and two sisters, Theresa and Ida.
