EMBORG PETERSEN

Emborg Petersen, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Nels Peter Petersen, was born August 6, 1903 in Aalborg, Denmark. He died April 6, 1985 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital in Harlan, Iowa, having attained the age of 81 years, and 6 months.

He was baptized in the Lutheran Church and attended school in Denmark where he learned the blacksmith trade.

In 1925, Emborg came to the United States. After living with his brother Walter at Massena, Iowa for a short time, Emborg moved to Exira, Iowa where he worked as a blacksmith. He later moved to Harlan, Iowa.

On September 28, 1936, Emborg was united in marriage to Olive Marie Wulf at his brothers home in Audubon, Iowa.

After they were married, Mr. and Mrs. Petersen made their home in Harlan, where Emborg continued to work as a blacksmith. After retiring, Emborg worked construction in Sioux City, Iowa, and also for the City of Harlan for a short time.

He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers, and five sisters.

Emborg is survived by his wife Olive of Harlan, a niece Frances Rasmussen of Exira, many nieces and nephews, other relatives and many friends.
