LLOYD PETERSEN, 67

WALNUT — Lloyd Nick Petersen, son of Nick and Amanda Beyer Petersen, was born on a farm south of Walnut April 8, 1909. Feb. 16, 1929 he married Lucille McLuen in Atlantic. This union was blessed with four children. She died Nov. 22, 1972 and on Dec. 18, 1973 he married Ann Gardner. They had just returned home from a trip to Florida when he became ill. He died at their home south of town Feb. 19, 1976 at age 67 years. Mr Petersen was a director of the Pottawattamie County Mutual Ins. Co. past president of the Peace Haven Home Ass'n. a director of the Walnut Housing Corp. and a member of the Atlantic Elks Lodge.

Survivors include his widow, Ann; three sons, Lloyd Rex Petersen of Avoca, Bruce and Max Petersen of rural Walnut; a daughter, Mrs Duane (Janice) Ellison of New Hope, Minn; ten grandchildren and a brother, Vernon Petersen of Atlantic.
