THE LIFE STORY OF —

Henry Poldberg, 84

Henry Poldberg was born March 11, 1898 two miles west of Kimballton. He was one of four boys born to Christian and Marie Hogensen Poldberg. He was baptized and confirmed in the Bethlehem Lutheran church in Jacksonville, Shelby Co.

He attended country school and then went into farming. Throughout his life he has worked numerous places. He worked on bridge construction crews and worked for Marietta Concrete Products in Des Moines for a time.

On Feb. 19, 1947 he married Beatrice Lillie whom he met in Des Moines. They were married at Our Savior Lutheran church in Audubon. They lived in Des Moines for 13 years.

They also lived for a short time in Kimballton. On Jan. 5, 1977 they moved to the Friendship Home in Audubon where he died on Monday, April 5, 1982 at the age of 84 years.

Surviving him are his wife, Beatrice, of Audubon, one brother, Chris of the Salem Lutheran Homes, Elk Horn, and numerous nieces and nephews. Preceding him in death were his parents, and his two brothers, Nels and Andrew.

Funeral services were held Wednesday, April 7, 1982 at the Bethlehem Lutheran church in Jacksonville, with Pastor Oliver S. Solberg, officiating. Burial was in the Bethlehem Lutheran church cemetery with Burdette Poldberg, Keith Poldberg, Lyle Poldberg, Dale Poldberg, Cordell Poldberg and George Lamer serving as casketbearers.
