

CHESTER F. QUICK, 87

Chester Franklin Quick, son of William and Mary Roland Quick, was born on Oct. 12, 1887, in Shelby county. He died at Myrtue Memorial hospital in Harlan, on April 12, 1975, at age 87 years and 6 months. Chester attended country school and grew to adulthood on the family farm west of Harlan. After graduating from the Omaha Barber College, he opened his own Barber Shop, located below the Paulk and Finn Clothing Store. He retired in 1959, after over 50 years as a barber. Mr Quick was a member of the First United Methodist church. On Oct. 12, 1909 he married Minnie Sargent in Harlan. To this union four children were born. After Mrs Minnie Quick's death in 1955, Chester continued to make his home in Harlan. On Aug. 28, 1958, he married Bessie DeBord in Co. Bluffs. After their marriage they made Harlan their home.

Mr Quick was preceded in death by two daughters - Frances (Mrs Glenn Beebe) and Fern; two sons, who died in infancy; one brother, Clarence Quick; and one sister, Mrs Goldie Blakely. He is survived by his wife, Bessie, of Harlan; his step-son, Donald DeBord, of Atlantic, two grandchildren, four great-grandchildren and one step-granddaughter; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held on Monday, April 14, 1975, at Pauley Funeral Home in Harlan, with Rev Larry LaVelle officiating. Burial was in the Harlan cemetery with Leonard Kay, Everett Quick, Jack Sorensen, Veral Sorensen, Lowell Sorensen, and Harold Lauridsen serving as casketbearers.
